

TOURIST ATTRACTIONS

- A Why not come and admire the artworks at Glass Paradise? Come and look at various glass object made by our glass makers as well as watch them while they are working and producing originals you can't find anywhere else. You can also buy many of the glass objects and find them in an e-shop on our website. Opening hours are Tuesday to Friday 10.00 a.m.–5.00 p.m., Saturday and Sunday 9.00 a.m.–6.00 p.m. Parking and wheelchair access available.
- B The Viking Ship Museum offers an unforgettable experience of Viking history and the best-preserved Viking ships in the north of Europe. You can also read about the Vikings and their sea adventures in interactive panels and children can play games with Viking theme. The adventure film *The Vikings Alive* is screened throughout the day on the ceilings and wall inside the museum. You can buy interesting souvenirs in the shop near the exit. Open daily from 10.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. except Thursdays.
- C Aquaria Water Museum gives you the chance to experience living Amazon rainforest with giant catfish, stingrays and piranhas. There is also a sea tank with sharks and a moray eel, as well as corals, anemones and schools of fish. You can find a café which serves hot and cold drinks as well as sandwiches and toasts and a shop which offers a variety of souvenirs at reasonable prices. Open daily from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. Parking available across the entrance.
- D Do you like school? If the answer is yes, then come and see the School Museum, where you can appreciate the various aspects of school life as lived by the 2 ethnic groups inhabiting the territory (Italian, German). The exhibition is complete with didactic materials, photographs, school reports, documents, furniture, and textbooks. Visits are available on request only. - E Hundreds of fascinating, outrageous and interactive exhibits will entertain the entire family in Ripley's Believe it or Not. Explore an unbelievable variety of artefacts and displays in 16 unique galleries that pay tribute to the odd and the strange, inspired by Robert Ripley himself. Be surprised at our collection of weird and unusual objects and rare treasures. Open daily from 10.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. except winter months, when we open at 11.00 a.m.
- F Come and visit Bird Island! This romantic island named for the enormous numbers of bird species is a kingdom of peace as opposed to the vibrant city of Cork found nearby. The island contains a bird sanctuary and a restaurant with stunning views of the surrounding cityscape. Convenient for bird lovers and everybody interested in nature and escaping from the stress of the city. Visits possible from spring till autumn.
- G Big and attractive botanical garden called Botanicus is one of the oldest in the world. It has more than 6,000 plants and some of the plants are really unique as 2000 years old agave cactus. In the recently renovated Orangery, a beautiful café with a large outside terrace open to the garden welcomes the visitors as well as a small café. Botanicus remains an oasis of peace and pleasurable attraction in the busy and crowded centre.
