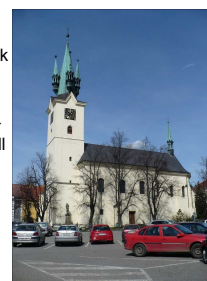

Holy Mountain

Holy Mountain is the most beautiful architectural monument of Příbram. The present shape dates from the beginning of the 18th century. You can see there a balustrade with statues of saints, four staircases and stucco decoration of the ceiling. Roofed steps link Příbram with Holy Mountain. On 22 June 1732 the Holy Mountain statue of the Virgin Mary was coronated. This event has been commemorated every year.
